My name is Karin Krakauer and I live at 643, NW 12th st, in the center of Corvallis, ten miles from Coffin Butte Landfill. I am submitting this testimony in response to two others already in the Board of Commissioners Reconsideration record, as relates to the DEQ Pre-enforcement notice:

Faye Yoshihara's testimony (Record ID BOC4\_T0778)

Over the years, especially during times of poor air quality in the valley, we have experienced Landfill stench ten miles away in the center of Corvallis, at our house. It makes us gag, feel nauseous, sometimes causes a headache. Although it is difficult to give specific dates from the past, we do remember we definitely smelled it on January 9th, as we were trying to decide about using our wood stove due to very poor air quality that day. We smelled the landfill again very strongly one day later that week, but not sure which date.

Coffin Butte Expansion needs to be denied due to the health risks from their emissions that affect those even ten miles away. So think how it is affecting those who live right next door.
