



SITE LIGHTING SUMMARY

The current operation of the Coffin Butte Landfill allows the site to open around 4:30 AM and ceases waste acceptance at 5:00 PM, Monday through Saturday. The site uses temporary lights or mobile lighting plants at the tipping face to allow for the landfill operations to be safely conducted, to see what is being disposed of at the tipping face, and complete daily cover placement. These lights are only used when natural light is insufficient to conduct safe operations. This same operation would eventually be moved to the expansion area.

The only additional lights that would be added to the Coffin Butte Landfill, would be security lights near the new parking lot for the new locker room building. These lights would be shielded or hooded so that they only face down towards the ground. These new lights would be designed and installed in accordance with all Benton County code requirements.

Other lights that might be installed, including some at the new scale house and leachate storage ponds would be activated by motion or be motion censored lights. They would also be shielded or hooded so that they only face down towards the ground.
