I've been working with Republic Services on the Coffin Butte regional landfill expansion just west of Highway 99W. As you're probably aware, the current site is filling up so they are moving directly south across Coffin Butte Road to continue their operations. This will have no impact on Highway 99W relative to the current site; Coffin Butte is a *Collector* and a *Freight Route*. The plan is to retain the current scales on the north side of Coffin Butte Road so that we keep that ¼ mile storage bay, with no change in residential access or circulation. Transfer trucks will take the residential materials across the street. Commercial trucks will have to weigh in, then turn right (west) onto Coffin Butte Road, then make a left to enter the new expansion area (with a new left-turn lane and improved Coffin Butte Road).

Let me know if you have any questions or comments, I had assumed Benton County had shared a copy with ODOT but it doesn't sound like that has happened. The enclosed includes the original TIA and a recent supplement. My expectation is that tomorrow evening's hearing will be extended, if there's a short note you could provide when you've had a chance to review this that would be very much appreciated.
