My name is Misty Bearden, and I am an employee of Thompson's Sanitary Service in Newport, Oregon. As a member of the waste industry, I am in a unique position to have a good understanding of how the closure of Coffin Butte landfill will impact my customers. I encourage you to grant Republic's application for expansion. Below are some of the reasons I support the expansion:

Choose some of these, or expand on them if you wish...

- The landfill is an essential resource in our ability to be responsible for our own waste
- Hauling the waste to a landfill further away doesn't fix the problem, it just makes people in another part of Oregon deal with our trash
- The trash we are talking about is our trash. It's yours, it's mine, it's all of ours together, and we should be the ones to deal with it responsibly
- Republic has done an excellent job managing the landfill
